

FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

All forms must be completed for scholarship consideration.

Deadline for filing (New students and graduating students applying to a new program): **MARCH 1, 2010**

Deadline for filing (Currently enrolled students): **APRIL 15, 2010**

For your application to be complete, please complete the three steps below:

1. **THE 2010-11 JULLIARD FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION**

Submit this application to the Financial Aid Office. Be sure to answer all questions; leave no blanks. If a question does not apply to you, please write "Not Applicable" or "None". Please convert all figures to U.S. dollars. Be sure to keep a copy for your reference.

Student Expense/Income Statement: This is not a projection of expected expenses and income for 2010-11, but a statement regarding the **prior** academic year. This is to help us determine your current financial need. It is important to estimate to the best of your ability.

Parent Information: Because Juilliard scholarship assistance is based partially on financial need, we evaluate all students' resources, including family resources. This may apply to graduate students. Please note that the FAFSA regulations regarding dependency status may differ from our requirement; however, these regulations apply to federal student aid only (i.e., federal Stafford loans). Juilliard applies a stricter definition of financial need for its own scholarship because these funds are limited.

2. **THE FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)**

For students who are U.S. Citizens and Permanent Residents. Apply online at www.fafsa.ed.gov and sign electronically using your PIN (www.pin.ed.gov). The Juilliard School code is 002742. You should have completed or estimated your 2009 Federal 1040 tax forms before completing the FAFSA. After you submit the FAFSA, Juilliard should receive it within 72 hours. You will also receive an email confirmation from the Department of Education; please read this carefully and be sure to follow up on any additional items required. **New York State Residents:** Be sure to apply for the New York State TAP grant at www.tapweb.org.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SUPPLEMENT

For students who are not U.S. Citizens or Permanent Residents. Please complete the International Student Supplement included in the Juilliard Financial Aid application if you are not a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident. If you apply online, the Supplement has already been included. Be sure to convert all figures to U.S. dollars.

3. **FEDERAL TAX FORMS**

For students whose families file taxes in the U.S. Please submit a complete, signed copy of your and your parents' 2009 Federal Tax Forms (1040), including W2, and/or 1099 forms and Schedules A-F. If you were not required to file a tax return, please submit a signed statement to that effect, and include copies of any W2s or 1099s received. If your parents did not provide financial support to you, you must submit documentation which shows how you supported yourself during the 2009-10 academic year.

SALARY DOCUMENTATION

For students whose families do not file taxes in the U.S. Please submit your and your parents' tax forms for the most recent tax year available. If your country does not have tax forms, please submit an official letter from your parents' employer(s) stating the total income earned in 2009. You must provide an English translation of all forms. If your parents did not provide financial support to you, you must submit documentation which shows how you supported yourself during the 2009-10 academic year.

OR

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Financial Aid includes scholarship, grants, loans and work-study. All scholarship decisions are based on a combination of merit and need; therefore all forms listed above must be received by the deadline for scholarship consideration. Students must reapply for scholarship financial aid every year. Lateness may result in a loss of all or part of scholarship assistance.

Please note that the Juilliard School reserves the right to make adjustments in scholarships, loans and work-study based on receipt of TAP grants and/or other grants and scholarships. Students who receive Juilliard Scholarships will be asked to submit a brief biographical statement for reporting purposes.
